



Prompts for Prayer Rwanda

- Pray for the Church as it negotiates with the government to open-up churches again and that they will have the resources needed to comply with government regulations (hand sanitiser stations, water tanks, space and seating for social distancing, thermal guns, face-masks).
- Pray for the believers who are unable to worship in church because they are not able to meet government guidelines above, and are worshipping at home, missing out on the joy of corporate praise.
- Pray for pastors who have no salary because the churches are closed
- Pray for the teachers at private church schools as the schools are closed and the staff are not receiving salaries, since these are paid from school fees. Pray that schools may be reopened, and that they would be able to build new classrooms to accommodate pupils in more socially distanced classes.
- Pray for the eradication of Covid-19, because the number of cases is increasing and many people are dying.
- Pray for the Diocese of Shyogwe as it continues to respond to the crisis and care for the most vulnerable members of society.
- Pray for the Diocese of Kibungo that they may be able to run the Diocesan offices, to carry out evangelism through broadcasting, and to support the pastors, in their respective parishes.
- Pray for those who are sick with the Covid-19, and the opening of the schools, now it's really a big challenge, children are at home, schools are closed, they don't have anything to do, they are now locked down at home, really the situation is not all that simple, so you can pray for that.
- Pray for communities in rural areas who have had to sell their domestic animals (such as goats, pigs & sheep) for their survival, that they may have the means to buy them again so that they can return to normal life, and obtain manure for fertilising their gardens so that they get enough yield to support themselves, and be able to take something to the market to earn money.
- Pray for those in Rwanda who lack means to pay for the medical insurance (each person pays 3,100 Francs - \$3.20).
- Pray for the 3 pastors from Kibungo Diocese (Moise Mutabazi, Emmanuel Ntakirutimana Rev. Ezechiel Habyarimana) who are in training at East Africa Christian University (EACU) supported by Knockbreda Parish. Due to the Government lockdown in March, the College had to shut down temporarily so the students have lost out on the greater part of their 2nd year studies.
