## March

### BURUNDI

**Mo 1.** The Vice President of Burundi, Prosper Bazombanza, recently acknowledged the contribution of the Church in community development. Pray that, as the Church and political leaders work together, truth, justice and peace will prevail.

**Tu 2.** In February, there were reports of insecurity in some areas of Burundi. People were attacked, injured and killed. Pray that these incidents will be properly investigated and the perpetrators brought to justice so that people can live without fear.

### Gitega Diocese

**We 3.** In a wonderful service in January, 28 priests, 25 deacons and three pastors were ordained. Give thanks for their calling and pray that God will guide them through His Holy Spirit and provide for them and their families.

**Th 4.** Parishes in Ireland supported the training of Rev Arsene, Rev Evariste, Rev Jeanine and Rev Francoise, who were recently ordained (*pictured*). Pray for them as they disciple and nurture their congregations and engage in mission in their communities.



**Fr 5.** Give thanks for the generous grant from Bishops' Appeal, enabling the Mothers' Union to extend the literacy and business skills programme to 320 rural women in two archdeaconries. Pray for the 16 facilitators as they deliver the training.

## CMSI FAMILY

### Staff

**Sa 6.** Pray for Roger Thompson in his work as Partnership Coordinator for Kenya, Nepal and Rwanda. Pray for Roger's family, particularly his mother Helen who recently moved into a Dementia Care Home in England. Pray that the restrictions on travel and visiting may soon be relaxed, so Roger can resume occasional visits.

Every year, Lamjung Hospital conducts free medical camps especially for poor people and those with disabilities, the elderly, women and children, living in in remote areas. This year due to the pandemic, their suffering is acute and they face real hardships. Access to treatment is very challenging.

Therefore, we plan to take the services to these vulnerable groups in their communities by visiting the villages and providing medical services, carrying out door-to-door medical support and distributing medicines. This will be done with appropriate infection control measures.

Please pray for the required resources, material and financial, to conduct the medical camps and for the favorable environment to be created.

## KENYA

### Kajiado Diocese

**Mo 8.** Pray for Bishop Gaddiel's quarterly pastoral programme across the diocese as things are still hard with Covid-19 restrictions and protocols. Ask God to bless the Kajiado Synod Standing committee meeting this Saturday and the dedication and blessing of Bishop's House on 24th April at Imaroro village.

**Tu 9.** Pray for more support and provision for those who have been adversely affected by Covid-19, suffering loss of jobs and lack of essential provisions. Pray too for the elderly and the young children who cannot attend church services.

### Urban Development Programme

**We 10.** Give thanks for Louise Githire (*pictured*), who retired from the staff of All Saints' Cathedral at the end of January. Pray for God's blessing as Louise spends more time with her family and as she, Lucy Irungu and Isabelle Prondzynski continue to work for the UDP in their personal capacities.



**Th 11.** Please pray for the students in the Tujisaidie School, which resumed in January after a nine-month suspension due to Covid-19. Pray for the candidates at national examinations, taking place later this month. These are essential for the transition to secondary school and to third-level education.

**Fr 12.** Pray for the young members of Tumaini African Foundation, who are resuming some sport, including table tennis and darts as well as board games. Give thanks for the growing Resource Centre and library, and pray for Zoom links being established with link churches in Ireland.

**CMSI FAMILY***Teams & Short-Term Experience Placements*

**Sa 13.** Give thanks for the recent selection of Tom and Gemma Withers – both physiotherapists – for an eight-month STEP at Kiwoko Hospital, Uganda beginning in early 2022. Pray for them in the coming months as they under take orientation through CMSI and for all the necessary plans to fall into place in God's timing.

**GENERAL PRAYERS***Resources & Initiatives*

**Su 14.** Give thanks for the recent launch of *Heroes Of Hope* – CMSI's new Children's Resource. Pray that, through this resource, God would inspire children and young people with His message of hope, for them and for our world.

**SOUTH SUDAN**

**Mo 15.** Rising numbers of Covid-19 cases at the beginning of the year brought new restrictions and many people are still living with the repercussions of these. Pray that the Church might be a place of hope for those who find themselves in despair.

*Yei Diocese*

**Tu 16.** Remember Bishop Hilary and Mama Joyce as they settle into retirement and seek God's guidance on what comes next. Pray for Bishop Hilary's successor as they take up the responsibility of leading Yei Diocese.

**We 17.** Pray for the diocesan primary, secondary and tertiary schools and colleges. They are reorganising after lockdown and also accommodating rising numbers of the community returning from refugee camps.

*Kajo Keji Diocese*

**Th 18.** Movement continues back into Kajo Keji from refugee camps and areas of displacement. Pray for Bishop Emmanuel and his team as they respond to the significant needs of those who are returning.

**Fr 19.** The churches in Kajo Keji have been displaced for the years of conflict. Pray for the restoration of parish administration so that communities can once again gather safely to worship.

**Sa 20.** Pray for Roger Cooke as he helps to plan and host the *Shine* online event and the monthly *Prayer Room* gatherings. Pray too that God would guide Roger and the staff team as they make decisions about how best to run the *Ignite* conference in September.

**GENERAL PRAYERS***Resourcing the vision*

**Su 21.** The audit was recently completed of CMSI's annual accounts. Give thanks for God's provision over the past year and the generosity of parishes and members. Please pray that the resources needed for the ongoing health of the society will be provided.

**NEPAL**

**Mo 22.** Pray for political stability and effective governance in Nepal, where the ruling party has collapsed and parliament has called for new elections. Pray for stability as the country as a whole, and the poor in particular, suffer economic collapse in the face of the ongoing corona epidemic.

*Human Development and Community Services*

**Tu 23.** Praise God for the online classes and meetings that were facilitated during lockdown with ABBS students and staff. Pray for school principal Tulsa Sharma as she liaises with parents and teachers to look at re-opening the school in a safe and secure way.

**We 24.** Give thanks for CoRIN – 'Community Radio Initiative Nepal' – one of HDCS's programmes. In January, they celebrated the 4th anniversary of Afno FM Rukum and the 12th anniversary of Afno FM Okhaldhunga. During the celebrations, the radio personnel visited the district prisons and hospitals and distributed fruit.

### The Zimmerman Family

**Th 25.** Pray for the Zimmerman family, who have been going through major transitions in recent months. Benjamin has transferred to boarding school in USA, where his brother is already in his first year of college, leaving Mark and Deirdre to continue their work in Nepal.

**Fr 26.** Please pray that Patan Hospital leadership will follow through on a commitment to hire Nepali staff in order to establish a dietetic department in this busy, 600-bed tertiary hospital. Pray for wisdom for Deirdre as she leads this endeavour.

#### Volunteers

**Sa 27.** Give thanks for all who continue to support CMSI with their time and skills, especially in this time of increased restrictions and obstacles. Pray for the Personnel Advisory Committee as they provide guidance and support on issues related to employees and mission personnel and help to put together new policies.

### DR CONGO

#### North Kivu Diocese

**Mo 29.** Pray for the vulnerable families displaced by violence into Butembo and for church members who have taken them in.

**Tu 30.** Pray for traumatised children accidentally separated from their families as they fled violence. Some of them are being cared for by Mama Mbambu at the Compassion for Children in Distress Project. Pray for the ongoing efforts to restore them to their families.

**We 31.** Pray for the Mothers' Union supporting and encouraging the women of the diocese.

## April

### UGANDA

**Th 1.** Pray for Uganda after the season of election instability, for families who have lost loved ones in the violence and for progress towards an equitable society.

### EASTER PRAYERS

#### Good Friday

**Fr 2.** *'We know that our old sinful selves were crucified with Christ so that sin might lose its power in our lives. We are no longer slaves to sin.'* We give thanks today for the cross, where we find true hope: the forgiveness and freedom to live and love. May we each live as those who are no longer slaves.

#### Easter Saturday

**Sa 3.** *'For we died and were buried with Christ by baptism. And just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glorious power of the Father, now we also may live new lives.'* May our lives be transformed as we participate in Christ's death and resurrection.

#### Easter Sunday

**Su 4.** *'Mary Magdalene found the disciples and told them, "I have seen the Lord!" Then she gave them his message.'* Christ is Risen! May we celebrate this news and share Christ's message of hope with others.

### SOUTH SUDAN

#### Olo Diocese

**Mo 5.** Bishop Tandema asks for prayer for this month's ordination of *"new people to serve the needs of the diocese."*

**Tu 6.** Pray for the preparations for the youth conference, which is due to take place in May. Pray for all who will attend.

### RWANDA

**We 7.** As cases of Covid-19 are increasing in Rwanda, please pray that the spread may be contained. Pray for the population, who have been returned to lockdown. Bishop Jered writes, *"Please pray for the eradication of the pandemic, and that enough vaccine can be found to reach all categories of people in Rwanda and in Africa."*

#### Shyogwe Diocese

**Th 8.** Continue praying for the pastors and their families as the churches have been closed again, with a severe impact on stipends which are normally paid from Sunday offerings. Pray too for the many thousands who normally survive by their daily wage labour, and who are now struggling with hunger.

**Fr 9.** Please pray for the diocesan schools, particularly the boarding schools. The parents are not able to pay fees and the diocese can't send students home, so the schools are obliged to feed them until the lockdown is over. It is also not possible to pay the teachers' salaries.

**Tu 13.** Pray for the theological college in Bukavu. Bishop Bahati writes: "We were training 30 students, but now the college is closed because of the Covid-19 situation."

**We 14.** Pray for the planned establishment of the new Diocese of Lac Tanganyika, from Bukavu Diocese. Pray especially for Bishop Tendwa Elisha who will come from Tanzania as a missionary to Uvira to help with preparation for this new diocese.]

**UGANDA****Madi West Nile Diocese**

**Th 15.** The diocese is thankful for the PPE and upscaling of hospital and clinics made possible through Misesan Cara funds. Pray that Covid-19 will remain under control in Madi West Nile.

**Fr 16.** Pray for Pastor Samiya at Ariye Parish within Bidi Bidi Refugee Camp and for all the pastors who have built and now lead refugee churches within the diocese.
