- Despite the harsh lockdown being enforced in Uganda due to C-19, resulting in real hardship for clergy and their parishioners - the food harvest has been plentiful and so God's family are no longer struggling with putting food on the table. Give thanks for God's provision.
- Bishop Eridard is requesting prayer for the government to have a robust plan of action in place to safely reopen schools and Churches in the coming months. Schools have been closed since March and this is having a detrimental impact upon the education of Uganda's children.

Madi West Nile Diocese

- Thank God for the ministries of MWN Diocese which have spread the message of hope through radio and home churches since the beginning of lockdown.
- Praise God for the lessons learned out of the Covid-19 crisis and the new vision which the Diocese has for moving forward. Pray that God would continue to give wisdom and guidance to Bishop Collins and his team as they lead the church.
- Pray for the outreach to refugees which has been interrupted by lockdown restrictions. MWN Diocese wants to continue their care for refugees as soon as it is possible.
- Pray for the Health Department of MWN Diocese as they seek to scale up their clinics and hospital to deal with the crisis, especially in relation to accessing supplies of PPE and basic hand washing in the surrounding communities.
- Pray for the young people who have been trained to make hand sanitiser, that they will be able to make an income and feel hope for the future in spite of delayed studies.
